Once questions have been answered, print out a copy of your answers and STAPLE your answers to *Page 6 only*.

1. Describe one situation or on-going activity in which you have clearly demonstrated leadership. Be explicit in explaining what you did that demonstrates leadership. (example: Do not simply say you were captain of a sports team; instead, explain what you did as the captain of the sports team that demonstrated leadership.) (20 Points)
2. Describe a service oriented activity that has been important to you. Explain not only what you have done but why it is important to you. (20 Points)
3. National Honor Society membership requires that you be able to demonstrate leadership, service, scholarship and character. Character is very difficult to measure. What qualities do you have that show that you are a “person of character”? It may be easiest to answer this question by giving an example where you demonstrated character. (20 Points)
4. NHS members are asked to complete community service hours over the course of the school year. Some of these hours are through projects that National Honor Society members sponsor. (For instance: to coordinate, collect, and deliver needed supplies to the animal shelter). What activity or type of activity do you think you might be interested in coordinating? (40 Points)
